GENERAL COUNCIL

Call to Order – Nancy Houlihan

Mission Statement: Sharing our Lord's Word, we: Make disciples; love God and neighbor, grow in God's grace and knowledge; glorify God!

Devotions—Pastor Laura – Lead devotions from our bulletin insert, "Taking faith home", reading the scripture and then asking the question, "Do you find it easy or difficult to forgive someone?" and a discussion followed.

Council Secretary's Report—Approval via email.

- Financial Secretary's Report—Mary presented her report, General offering \$15,602.00, Globe \$126.72, Youth \$20.00, Interest \$8.05, Wednesday Meals \$511.00 and Other Giving (Easter Lilies) \$296.00. Total Deposit \$16,563.77. David made a motion to approve the financial report, Wendy seconded, the motion carried.
- Treasurer's Report From Wendy's report, Total All Giving \$16,563.77 which is above the Budget of \$12,448.42. YTD Total All Giving: \$38,981.83, which is below the Budget of \$50,656.66. Expenses \$14,518.94, below the Budget of \$17,592.41. Expenses YTD \$46,686.45 which is lower than Budget of \$52,845.40. Looking ahead, our insurance will be increasing along with the cost of our garbage service. Mike made a motion to approve the Treasurer report, Natalie seconded, the motion carried.

Pastor's Report – Since our last Council Meeting:

- Lent and the entire Easter season has been very busy and everything went extremely well.
- Normal Ministry now continues and there will be a meeting with the 4 young people that will be confirmed on Wednesday, April 24th from 7-8 pm to rehearse and turn in their projects and will be Confirmation will be held on April 28, 2024.
- Visitations and prayers have continued for our members who are ill or have been hospitalized.
- Pastor Laura did attend the Spring Theological Conference in Brookings on April 2nd, 3rd and 4th.
- We will honor our High School Graduates during our church service on May 5, 2024. Our graduates are: Rylan Aman, Gavin Johnson, Bailey Schipper and Chase Obbink. Mary made a motion to approve the Pastor's report and Amy seconded, the motion carried.
- A discussion was held regarding our summer Wednesday Boost services or to replace those services with a 16 week Bible study, "The Greatest Story", which will give all participants an overview of the entire Bible. Because of low attendance, the decision was made to try the Bible Study this summer beginning on May 8, 2024. A motion was made by Amy and seconded by Deanne to proceed with the Bible Study. A sign-up sheet will be circulated as books will need to be purchased. Mary made a motion to approve the Pastor's report, Tim seconded, the motion carried.

- A very successful Easter Egg hunt was held indoors on March 23rd and was well attended! Thank you to all who donated candy to fill eggs and volunteered their time to make this event a success!

- Vacation Bible School is tentatively set for August 6,7 and 8, 2024 and plans are being made to again make this a success. As plans are finalized, more information will be given. Mike made a motion to approve the report, Tim seconded, the motion carried.


